## JAAI - An Alumni Movement

### Objectives

- Bring Alumni Associations together – forum for networking
- Encourage formation of Associations
- Link with Associations across the world
- Role in shaping public policies in favour of secularism, alleviation of poverty, empowerment of women, upliftment of marginalized, safeguard human rights, preservation of environment and spread of literacy.

### History of Jesuits, India and JAAI

The Federation of Jesuit Alumni Associations of India (JAAI) is an association of all alumni associations of Jesuit academic institutions in India. It hopes to bring together all Jesuit alumni in the country together and direct their energies for the betterment of the society.

### How it all began ..The Jesuits, India and JAAI

The Jesuit Order "Society of Jesus" was founded by St. Ignatius of Loyola in 1530s. One of his first companions was the then professor of the Paris University, Francis Xavier, who came to India in 1542. He opened the first Jesuit school in Goa in 1543. It was named St. Paul's College. Nothing exists of this institution today except its memory, but it was the predecessor of hundreds of other schools and colleges. JAAI is also affiliated to the World Union of Jesuit Alumni.

Today, in India the Jesuits conduct not less than 38 university colleges, 5 Institutes of Business Administration and 155 high schools spread throughout the country, almost all of them among its most reputed (for example: St. Xavier's, Kolkata, Mumbai, Ranchi, Loyola, Chennai, Vijayawada; St. Joseph's, Bangalore, Tiruchy, XRI Jamshedpur, XIMB, Bhuvaneshwar). In them, more than 250,000 students belonging to every religious, linguistic and socio-economic group, receive their education.

JAAI was conceived at the Jesuit Alumni Congress in Chennai in 1995. Since then it has taken shape as an organization, with a Governing Council, Constitution and a rotating Secretariat in place. It has also hosted five national congresses and an international congress.

### Preamble

As beneficiaries and as inheritors of the Jesuit/Ignatian legacy of Education, the members of several Alumni/Aliae Associations have come together to form a Federation, bonded in love and fellowship, endeavor to become men and women for others.

### Governing Council

- Three per Zone, Ex officio on World Union, Jesuit Advisor, Patron
- Meet twice a year, First meeting at National Congress.
- Formulate policies
- Monitor activities of the Federation and its administration
- Monitor and guide activities of Zonal Councils
- Organize National Congress
- Select representatives for World Union

### Zones

- North: Calcutta, Patna, Darjeeling, Delhi and Kohima Provinces
- South: Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Madurai Provinces
- West: Goa, Pune, Bombay and Gujarat Provinces
- Central: Dumbka Raigarh, Madhya Pradesh, Hazaribagh, Jamshedpur and Ranchi Provinces

### Zonal Council

- Four Members per Province of that zone plus Province co-ordinators
- Province Coordinators vote only in event of a tie
- Select representatives for Governing Council
- Organize Zonal Congress six months before National Congress

### Membership

- Founder members 28
- Open only to recognized Alumni Associations of Jesuit Educational Institutions
- Certificate of Recognition required from head
- Only one association per Institution
- Applications to Governing Council

### Fees

- Entrance Rs 2000, Fees Annual Rs 1,000.
- Province to balance amounts internally to support smaller associations.



## JAAI DIARY



The meet in Chennai in 1995 was the first congregation of Jesuit Alumni/ae in India. Till then there was no officially formed body of the alumni/ae at the national level and it was an effort undertaken by the alumni/ae associations of the Southern Province led by Loyola School Alumni, Chennai.

Alumni of St.Xavier's Calcutta have been very active in the country and was truly demonstrated by being one of the largest contingent from outside the host region comprising amongst others, the then Chief Minister of West Bengal (Late) Jyoti Basu, Kalyan Chowdhury, Krishna Kumar Kanoi, Dr.Suman K Mukherjee, Jeetu Rampaaria and others. The contingent from Calcutta Province was led by the then Province Co-ordinator Fr.P.C.Mathew -the then Principal of St Xavier's College Calcutta and President of St.Xavier's College (Cal) Alumni Association.

Befitting the experience and action charged team of Calcutta Province, the congregation decided to formally organise the Indian Alumni Movement and mandated the Calcutta Province to host the next congregation in Calcutta and COAC (Committee of Jesuit Alumni Congress) was formed with Rev fathers Andre Bryant, P.C.Mathew, A. Wavall-being the Presidents of Alumni Associations of St. Xavier's Collegiate School, St. Xavier's College and St.Lawrence High School (all of Calcutta) alongwith a team comprising of Kalyan Chowdhury, Siddhartha Duttcharya, Krishna Kanoi, Dr.Subrata Das, Jeetu Rampaaria and others.

Thus the idea of a National Level body was mooted. To get organised formally, the first need was the character of the body and its charter and rules and regulations. Hence A Constitution Committee was formed under the stewardship of Fr.P.C.Mathew which gave alumni movement in India :

- a. Its name of Federation of Jesuit Alumni/ae Associations in India (FJAAI)
- b. Constitution and Bye Laws,
- c. Character of a Federation wherein all the recognised Alumni/ae associations of jesuit educational institutions were to become members at the National level
- d. In order to generate momentum and also focussed attention for nurturing the nascent movement, Zonal Councils were introduced. These Zones were on the lines of the SI's administrative set up in India.

Thus the 1st Formal National Congress of Indian Alumni/ae was held in Jan 1999 and Mr.Krishna Kumar Kanoi was elected as the first President of the Federation with Mr.Conrad Gonsalves as the Secretary.

The impetus to the Indian Jesuit Alumni/ae movement generated further momentum by earning mandate to organise the VIII World Congress in India in 2003 and Calcutta was the obvious choice. The Organising Committee of the World Congress was constituted comprising of various alumni from the 3 jesuit institutions of Calcutta with Jeetu Rampaaria as the Secretary under the stewardship of Gen (Retd) Shankar Roychowdhury as the President. The Congress was inaugurated by the then President of India Sri. A.P.Abdul Kalam in the presence of the then Governor of WB (Late) Vinay J Shah and the Congress was blessed by the graceful presence of Rev Father Superior General Kolvenbach S.J.

The constitution of FJAAI realising the importance of nurturing a new movement, while gave the broad contours of the organisation structure, principles, motto, administrative set up, rules, regulations etc but let the modalities be free from rigidity and left it to get evolved by precedences and the prudence of the Council Members depending upon the socio-economic-political and other factors. It is in light of this the National Congress is held in different Zones every 3 years and a rotation in Office bearers from different zones provides opportunity to every zone in playing important role in spearheading the movement.

FJAAI or JAAI movement right in its infancy generated its importance and found reckoning in the World Forum-WUJA-World Union of Jesuit Alumni- and in 2003 Calcutta Congress, the then FJAAI President Krishna K Kanoi and Secretary Conrad Gonsalves were appointed WUJA Board Members representing South East Asia Pacific region. Since then WUJA continues to have JAAI representation on its Board.

## JAAI National Programme Blood Donation

### AJMIT - Mangalore

"Spread smiles by donating blood" indeed was the motto followed by the organizers and participants at St Aloysius Institute of Management and Information Technology (AJMIT), St Aloysius College, for Sanjeevini 2013 the blood donation camp. The camp was inaugurated by Dr Yusuf Kumble, one of the India's leading Interventional Cardiologists of Indiana hospital along with Fr Pradeep Sequeira SJ, Administrator of AJMIT, Dr Rowena Wright, Dean of MBA Faculty, Divya Pereira, the Faculty Coordinator and Elton Pereira, the Student Coordinator.

Throughout the day various hospitals with the help of the student representatives made the day a very successful and memorable one. It was a heart tendering experience seeing students as well as faculty volunteered to donate blood. This is consecutively 5th year, the students of AJMIT are organizing the Blood Donation Camp.

In preparation for the Blood Donation Camp, the students of MBA enacted a street play at Beeri, Thokkattu and Derakatte to inform the public about the Blood Donation Camp and also apprise them of the benefits of blood donation.

## DOX RANCHI

Doranda Old Xavierians (DOX) the alumni association of St. Xavier's School, Doranda, Ranchi has been involved in Blood Donation and Awareness Camps for a long time now. Donation Camps are organized every 1-2 months and all the blood collected goes to the local Government Blood Bank. Along with some other organizations, the blood collected has reached a level where the shortage is almost taken care off. In fact the local blood bank new requests that only rare group be collected since there is more blood than the stocking capacity of common blood groups.

In the awareness camps, DOX members visit schools in Ranchi and around and lecture on the pros and cons of blood donation to the students of Classes 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>. The aim is to make them aware and conscious of the benefits as well as the social impact of blood donation. These children, it is hoped, will be active donors in the future.



A list of persons who are ready to donate blood at short notice is maintained and in emergencies, these volunteers rush to the hospitals when required. Particular care is taken in compiling a list of people with rare blood groups. Their blood is not taken in blood camps and they are motivated to volunteer in emergencies. Phone numbers of COB members are on display at hospitals, on face book and with many people so that they can be contacted in emergencies.

It has been planned that in the near future, all institutions in a province will hold camps on the same date-with a lot of advertisement so that it becomes highlighted and the program becomes well known to the needy, particularly in rural areas. It is targeted that in the next 1-2 years, there should be no shortage of blood in Ranchi area.

This school is built by Fr Henri Depelchin the one who built St.Xavier's Kolkata.


The school will complete the year long celebrations in April.
